

Special Event Recycling Bins Available for FREE Rental

The St. Croix County Recycling program has 40 recycling bins available for free rental for special events within the county. The bins have been checked out for graduation parties, weddings, meetings, football games, town festivals and more. The bins are available for any gathering that you would like to provide recycling at.



The recycling bin rental includes an x-frame and lid along with two clear plastic bags per recycling bin. Extra clear plastic bags can be purchased for \$5/unit, which includes 10 additional bags per unit. A \$50 deposit per bin rented is requested to rent the recycling bins and will be returned to the renter upon return of all recycling bins in good shape.

Waste Reduction Tips: DIY Natural Cleaners

We all know the saying: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle—but do you know that it should be done in that order? Reuse and recycling are great, don’t get me wrong, but “reduce” might be the most important “R” of them all. One way to reduce waste and harmful chemicals in your home is to make your own homemade natural cleaners. Homemade natural cleaners not only reduce the amount of hazardous waste in your home but are easy to make, inexpensive and use ingredients that you are likely to already have around the house. Below is a recipe for an easy, non-toxic, all-purpose cleaner that can be used to clean many surfaces in your home. All Purpose Cleaner

- 32 oz spray bottle
- 1/4 cup white vinegar
- 2 tsp. borax
- 3 ½ cups hot water
- 20 drops of your favorite essential oil (optional)
- ¼ cup liquid dish soap

In a 32 oz spray bottle, add borax, vinegar and water. Mix thoroughly. Add the essential oils if desired then add dish soap last.



2014 Residential Recycling Tonnage Rises Again in St. Croix County

The 2014 recycling tonnage has been gathered and the results are impressive. 7,334 tons of recyclables were collected in St. Croix County last year! This is a 52% increase in the amount of recycling collected in 2013. This resulted in a per capita recycling rate of nearly 194 pounds per person.

This is great news and reflects only part of the recycling done by county residents. The data is only for recyclables such as plastic, aluminum, tin, glass, newspaper, cardboard and mixed paper. It does not include the other types of items recycled by St. Croix County residents such as appliances, electronics, tires, waste oil and yard waste. It also does not include material recycled by the 10% of St. Croix County residents who live in municipalities not affiliated with the St. Croix County recycling program. Great job St. Croix County residents and keep up the good work!

Latex Paint Now Accepted at Clean Sweep

Latex paint will be accepted for the first time at this year's Clean Sweep Hazardous Waste collection for a fee. Fees will be \$25/5 gallon, \$5/gallon, \$2/quart and pints are free. Fees are based on the size of the can, not the volume of paint within the can. For example, a gallon can that is half full will be charged \$5. Several cans of latex paint can be combined to save money, as long as it fits within the container and the lid can be securely attached. Fees can be payable by cash or check at the event.

Farms and businesses must pre-register for the event by calling the county recycling specialist at 715-531-1907 by May 8th. Businesses must generate less than 220 lbs of hazardous waste per month to qualify as a very small quantity generator (VSQG) and be eligible to participate. Business collection is a fee for service event. The first 500 lbs of waste are free for farms and households. Fees may apply for certain types of waste.
