

## **CHAPTER 58**

### **POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA**

#### **SECTION 1.**

“Drug paraphernalia” has the definition contained in Wis. Stats. §961.571 or any subsequent amendment thereto.

#### **SECTION 2.**

No person may use, or possess with the primary intent to use, drug paraphernalia to plant, propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, conceal, inject, ingest, inhale or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance or controlled substance analog as defined in Wis. Stats. §961.01(1).

#### **SECTION 3.**

Any person who violates this ordinance may be fined not more than \$500 and, in default of the payment of the fine, imprisoned in the St. Croix County Jail for not more than 30 days.

#### **SECTION 4.**

Any person who violates this ordinance who is under 17 years of age is subject to a disposition under Wis. Stats. §938.344(2e).

#### **SECTION 5.**

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication pursuant to Wisconsin Law (effective the day after publication).
