

**Farmland Preservation Area Plan map & Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use map
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

The St. Croix County Community Development Committee will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, September 15, 2016 at 5:00 p.m., or shortly thereafter, at the Hudson Government Center's County Board Room, 1101 Carmichael Road, Hudson, Wisconsin**, to consider the proposed amendments to the St. Croix County Farmland Preservation Area Plan map and Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use map to reflect the following:

- 1) Revise the Farmland Preservation Area Plan map to reflect changes in the Town of Star Prairie future land use map.
- 2) Revise the Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use map to be consistent with the Town of Star Prairie and Town of Somerset Future Land Use maps.

The committee meeting will start at 5:00 p.m. with the hearing to begin shortly thereafter. County staff will provide a short presentation and answer questions before public comments are heard.

In response to recent updates to the Town of Star Prairie Comprehensive Plan St. Croix County revised its farmland preservation area plan map and future land use map. The updates will allow the Town of Star Prairie to become a certified farmland preservation zoning town. In addition updates to the Town of Somerset 2015-2035 Comprehensive Plan will be incorporated into St. Croix County's Future Land Use Map.

Copies of the draft maps are available at the Community Development Department, Government Center, Hudson and the Agriculture Service & Education Center, Baldwin. The documents may also be viewed or downloaded from the St. Croix County website at: www.sccwi.us/countycompplan.
