

2016 DEER HUNTING POLICY

GLEN HILLS COUNTY PARK

In 2016, deer hunting will be allowed for the following seasons:

*Archery	November 1—January 8
*Crossbow	November 1—January 8
Gun	November 19—November 27
Muzzleloader	November 28 —December 7
#Antlerless Gun	December 8—December 11

- * The park will be open for archery and crossbow season beginning November 1.
- # Glen Hills is in the Central Farmland Zone. Antlerless Deer Carcass Tags are required for the Antlerless Hunt December 8—December 11.

- All State deer hunting regulations must be adhered to in addition to the following:
- Deer hunting in future years will be dependent upon a favorable experience in 2016 and subject to annual review by the Parks Division and parent committee.
- Off-road vehicle traffic is prohibited. Vehicles must remain on roads and parking lots. No ATV's, dirt bikes, or snowmobiles during any season.
- No camping allowed.
- No permanent tree stands or blinds.
- Portable tree stands and blinds must be completely removed daily at the end of hunting hours.
- No screw in tree steps or hardware in trees.
- No cutting of living trees or limbs larger than 1" in diameter.
- No baiting allowed.
- Hunting will only be allowed in the shaded areas on the attached map. Please note that the day-use areas and the campground are closed to hunting. Hunting in closed areas will be considered trespass.
- Respect private lands—do not trespass on neighboring lands, get personal permission from the respective landowner.
- Hunting violations and/or damage to buildings or facilities will be grounds to cancel all future hunting privileges.

- If a wounded deer enters into an area closed to hunting, you cannot take your firearm or bow into the closed area. One or two members of the hunting party will be allowed to track and retrieve the carcass from the closed area.
