BIN CHECKOUT PROGRAM

The County has bins for checkout.

How to get started -

1. Contact County to reserve bins.
2. Complete the reservation form. St. Croix County staff will help event planners determine the number of bins and bags needed and develop a plan for setup, servicing bins and removal of recyclables.
3. Pick up bins.
4. Recycle at event.
5. Return bins.



Fees -

- Refundable deposit
- Specially-sized clear plastic bags: Two bags furnished- additional bags (in units of 10) are \$5 per unit.

For ongoing events: Borrow bins to try! You may want to purchase your own bins to use full time. Contact St. Croix County for more information.
