Purpose:

St. Croix County is requesting stakeholder input into its conceptual Farmland Preservation Zoning Districts. The next step in the St. Croix County Farmland Preservation Plan is to focus on an acceptable comprehensive revision to the Exclusive Agricultural Zoning district while meeting state criteria required for tax credits.

- The open house format was chosen to offer greater opportunities for attendance and individualized discussion about farmland preservation zoning.
- County staff will be give two brief presentations and will be available throughout the time remaining to answer questions.
